### ROCKY POINT FIRE/EMS BOARD

All five Board members, Fire Chief, and 3 guests, Nick Ryan, Loren, & Leland Otis, attended the May Board meeting. After initial business, Chad reported 1 fire mutual aid, 1 public assist, 1 medical w/o transport, and 1 with. Volunteers logged 49 hours of training for the previous month.

Reporting for the VFA, Nick introduced our newest volunteer, Leland Ortis, and said the new garage door is in, complete with 2 controllers.

Mike Igou, reporting for the Board, confirmed that Quilt will fund \$2000 in materials for the new Disaster Building. Part of that amount was unspent from the 2011 quilt raffle income. Dean ordered a new canopy for the BBQ.

Old business consisted of approving a maximum of \$4000 to be spent on the Disaster Building, which hopefully will be up by the BBQ. Loren will inform the public on the use of the building and training for a disaster.

New business covered the cost of training for out-of-area volunteers. Chad also updated the Board on letters of commitment from the new volunteers, who will serve our district for 48 hours a month. He reminded the Board we need lodging for the out-of-town volunteers coming for their

duty time. Budget will seek final approval at the June 12<sup>th</sup> meeting. Board approved Chad’s request to submit a VFA grant for radio equipment. The grant carries a 50% match from the department.

After reminders of special dates—July 21<sup>st</sup> BBQ & our fire department’s biggest fundraiser with a huge day of wonderful things going on, Sept. 10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> Cycle Oregon, Sept. 22<sup>nd</sup> Lake of the Woods Car Show—the meeting adjourned.
