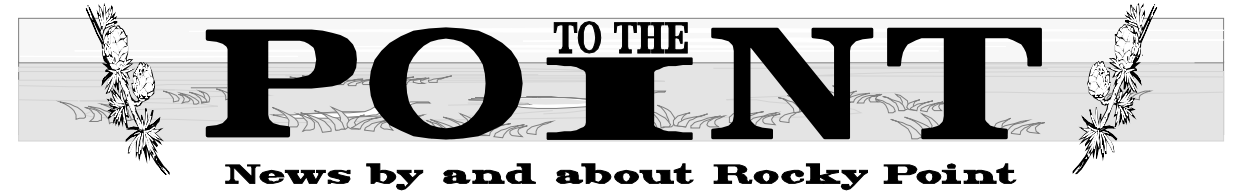

Four Board members and the Fire Chief attended the August meeting. After disposing of the minutes and financial matters, Treasurer Terry requested that the department purchase a computer for the exclusive use of the treasurer and Board members.

Fire Chief reported on calls for the previous month - 6 medical without transport, 1 intercity transport, 1 medical with transport, 2 motor vehicle accidents with transport, 1 burn, and 1 mutual aid to Chiloquin. The volunteers logged 47 hours of training, with Nickie Caroon logging 48 hours in Rocky Point.

Old business consisted of a letter to the department from Dave Epling, regarding housing for our volunteers from out of town.

New business began with an alert for everyone in the community to be aware our ISO rating is 8B. That makes a very big difference when homeowner's policy rates are determined. Anybody interested in co chairing the 2013 July BBQ should contact Rita (542 356-2233).
