All Board members, Fire Chief, and 6 guests (Jerry Higgins, Nick Ryan, Diane Grieb, Tess Dillenberger, Julie Black, and Annie Wicklund) attended the December meeting. Secretary and treasurer submitted minutes and financial reports from November, which were approved.

Chad reported 7 volunteer responses and 63 hours of training. Jerry & Nick gave the volunteer's report, and Rita gave a Board of Directors report.

Old business began with representatives from Quilt submitting suggestions on how 2012's quilt raffle money (\$2500) could be used.
