ROCKY POINT FIRE/EMS BOARD

All Board members, Fire Chief, and 9 guests attended the May meeting. Rita then presented Jerry Higgins, who retired as Captain of the fire department in February, an award for his service from 2001 to 2013.

Minutes of the previous meeting were approved and the treasurer's report accepted. Fire Chief Loren Head reported 9 calls and two nights of training. The Board agreed to possibly sell vehicle 2172, due to mechanical problems. All other equipment is up and running.

The VFA is still looking for a secretary/treasurer. Contact a Board member if you can help. The Board approved contracting Kathy Ross to help with various clerical tasks, service to be paid from the Casual Labor Fund. Rita will contact ODOT about hwy 140 signage.

Old Business covered Terry's work on a brochure to distribute at the July BBQ. No progress has been made on installing access to the septic tank, so that item is on hold for now. The Board agreed on an amount available for purchasing a Fire Chief's truck.

New Business began with announcement of the final Budget Committee meeting. The Board has conducted one interview for the Fire Chief

position, but no decision was made. The Board agreed to participate in mutual aid with other departments. Greg Sullivan is working on continuation of Fire/Med ground service only. Mercy Flight air lift service will be the responsibility of individual customers, but Rita can provide information on that service.

A final reminder that our department desperately needs additional fire and medical volunteers. Please contact the department if you would like to know more, or if you know of someone who might be interested (356-2205).
