## ROCKY POINT FIRE/EMS BOARD

All 5 Board members, fire chief, and a guest attended the January meeting. Minutes and treasurer’s report were approved. Chad summarized volunteer activity, which consisted of 3 responses and 29 hours of training. He also confirmed that the fire department purchased AED machines to place at Lake of the Woods and Rocky Point Resorts.

Loren, representing the VFA, had nothing to report from that group, but he did spend some time discussing the Disaster Plan. He received more money to go toward the purchase of items needed for it.

Old Business again addressed the need for more volunteers. A community meeting was scheduled for Jan. 24<sup>th</sup> to generate ideas, and publicity will go out announcing the meeting. For more details on that meeting’s outcome, see February’s newsletter, or contact Terry Roberts. A 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting, the first to plan the July BBQ, will be on Feb. 13<sup>th</sup>.

Final Old Business was an announcement that the quilt raffle income from 2012 funded the recent Quicken training class for Terry Roberts, as well as attendance expenses for Rita, Mike, and Tony to participate in the annual SDAO

conference. Both sessions were held in Portland.

The 4 items in New Business began with assessments, which haven’t changed since 1969. Securing dependable snow removal at the fire hall was the 2<sup>nd</sup>. Considering Yummy’s as a caterer for the BBQ followed, and the final item was performance standards and the fire chief’s contract.
