

Three appointed board members, assistant fire chief, and the clerk met for the April meeting. After opening routines, Bonnie Todd and Sandy Handsaker were sworn in as newly-appointed board members.

President Hill announced to the 30 or so guests that Good and Welfare comments would be postponed until next meeting. Minutes and treasurer’s report were approved, followed by the chief report of 7 drills, prefire plans, 2 medical calls, 1 citizen assist, 3 fire-related calls and one MVA.

President’s report addressed the chief’s absence and thanks to the previous board members.

The federally-required DUNS and SAM numbers have been assigned and 2 grant requests are in motion.

President proposed forming a citizen committee to meet with Lake of the Woods homeowners to address their fire protection. Rita and Kathy resigned as chairs for the upcoming BBQ, and a meeting has been scheduled to determine the future of the event.

The chief and board met with our insurance agent and an SDAO representative to clarify liability issues. A review of the department was conducted.

Next month’s meeting will cover the chief’s review, quilt donations, Fire Med, and Aspen room liability.
