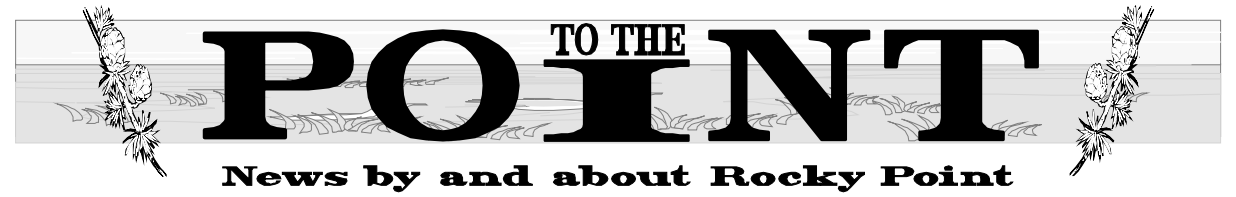

ROCKY POINT FIRE/EMS BOARD

The March meeting opened routinely, followed by the swearing in of new board member Rosie Roberts, replacement for Terry Roberts who resigned. All board members were present, as well as assistant fire chief and 19 guests, many of whom spoke about a number of concerns they had about fire department operations and board management.

Minutes of the February meeting were read and approved, as was the treasurer’s report. Glenn, on behalf of the fire chief, reported 1 medical call and several hours of volunteer training. Christy McLaren followed with additional information on volunteer training.

Board’s report began with the official resignation Terry Roberts, followed by approval to increase the assistant chief’s stipend to \$1000 per month. Policy and Guidelines Manuel update is complete and was approved. Fred Hill will conduct interface for public requests for documents, and Fred and Rosie Roberts will be responsible for personnel issues. Much of the missing equipment has been returned.

Old business addressed the upcoming BBQ meeting and approval of the following motion: “All gifts, donations, or monies received from all people or entities to be given to the Rocky Point Fire/EMS district directly to be deposited in to RP Fire/EMS checking account and distributed by the district.”
